Bike Trail & Walking Path

Includes a 2.5-mile walking and bike trail that extends from 1.5 miles north of El Paso to South Pointe Park and bisects the community. 5.0 miles in total going down and back.

Corn Belt Park

This park offers:

Jefferson Park (Library Park)

AMERICAN BUILDING REC CENTER

You may use the bathrooms which are located in the lobby. The facility can be rented in 2-hour increments. Each additional hour will be a charge of \$25 per hour. Set up and tear down must be completed during your rental period.

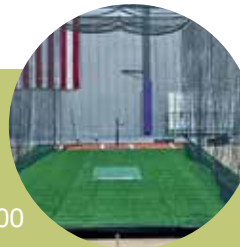

GOLF SIMULATORS

Simulators will be rented by per hour with a maximum of four people in the simulator area. Generally, it takes one hour per person to play 18 holes, if you have two people, we recommend renting the simulator for two hours. The multi-sport simulator features sports such as baseball, basketball, soccer, hockey, football, cornhole, and many more. The pricing for this will be the same as the golf simulator. There will also be golf simulator leagues in the winter, pricing and specific dates for those leagues will be available at a later date.

Basketball

Biddy Basketball is for children that are in Pre-K through Kindergarten for the 2026-27 school year. This program is an instructional camp that focuses on learning the fundamentals of basketball through drills, interactive games, and skill training. The camp will take place over four Saturdays in the months of January, February and March with the fifth week being a game. Registration for Biddy Basketball will open on November 16th and close on December 28th. The camp schedule, rules, and other information will be issued in mid-January. The fee is \$40.00 per player. There will be a discounted fee for individuals with rec center memberships.

First & Second Grade In-house Basketball is for children that are in first and second grade for the 2026-27 school year. This program is going to be a hybrid of a camp/game structure. The 1st and 2nd grade divisions will take place over 6 weeks. The first two weeks will be an instructional camp where camp will focus on learning the fundamentals of basketball through drills, interactive games, and skill training. The final four weeks of the season will be games. Each team will play one game on the final four Saturdays against other teams in their age division. If numbers allow it, the divisions will be split into a boy's division and a girl's division. Once games begin, teams will be allowed one practice a week. Registration for First & Second Grade In-House Basketball will open on November 16th and close on December 28th. The roster, game schedule, practice schedule, and rules will be issued in mid-January. The games will take place on Saturdays in January, February, and March. The fee is \$45.00 per player. There will be a discounted fee for individuals with rec center memberships.

Third and Fourth Grade In-House Basketball is for children that are in Third Grade and Fourth Grade for the 2026-27 school year. This program features assigned teams, one or two practices per week, and games on Friday evening or Saturdays. There will be a girl's division and a boy's division. Registration for Third and Fourth Grade In-House Basketball will open on November 16th and close on December 28th. The roster, game schedule, practice schedule, and rules will be issued in mid-January. The games will take place in January, February, and March. The fee is \$50.00 per player. There will be a discounted fee for individuals with rec center memberships.

Travel Basketball is being offered for basketball players that are looking for a higher level of competition and an advanced playing situation for boys and girls in fifth and sixth grade as of the 2026-27 school year. This program is designed to give the basketball players from El Paso-Gridley the opportunity to play against other quality teams from the surrounding area. This program is structured to be more competitive than the El Paso Parks & Recreation In-House Basketball program and playing time is not guaranteed. Games will may fall on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday or Saturdays depending on the opponent's gym availability. El Paso Recreation will be the host of a new league and all 5th & 6th grade games will take place at the Rec Center. All practices will take place at the American Buildings Recreation Center. This program features one or two practices per week and two or three games per week.

Registration

Registration for 5th and 6th grade Girls Travel Basketball will open on July 20th and close on August 3rd. Practices will start in late August, while games will go from mid-September to early December.

Registration for 5th and 6th grade Boys Travel Basketball will open on August 10th and close on August 23rd.

Practices will start in late October, while games will go from mid-November to early January. The fee is \$115.00 per player. If the individual or family has a recreation center membership, they will receive a \$10 discount on registration. Once practices have started, no issues will be refunded if a player decides to no longer play. At this time, we will only be taking the first 12 players to register for the program. There will be a waitlist that you may register for if you do not meet the 12-player maximum. If there are a lot on the waitlist, we will hold a tryout or find another option for kids to participate.

Tiny Titans

Tiny Titans is offered for kids that are 7 years old and younger for a morning of fun at a discounted rate during the winter months. There will be sports equipment, gymnastics equipment, building blocks, large connect 4, and more! No pre-registration is required for this program. Tiny Titans will go from November through March on Thursday mornings from 8:30 AM - 10:30 AM at the American Building Rec Center. The fee for this program is \$2.00 per child. Parents are free.



Kid's Winter Dance Camp

Does your child love to move, groove, and express themselves through dance?

Join us for a high-energy, two-day Kids Dance Camp full of rhythm, fun, and creativity!

Get ready to move at our Kids Winter Dance Camp!

In this exciting camp, dancers will:

- Perform a short routine for family at the end of camp!

Pending the instructors availability, specific dates and times for this program will be announced at a later date. The fee will be \$20 per child.

Travel Volleyball

Travel Volleyball is being offered for volleyball players that are looking for a higher level of competition and an advanced playing situation for fifth and sixth grade girls for the 2026-27 school year. This program is designed to give the volleyball players from El Paso-Gridley the opportunity to play against other quality teams from the surrounding area. This program is structured to be more competitive than the El Paso Parks & Recreation In-house Volleyball program. If there are enough girls registered and we need to create two teams, we will look into that option so that all girls can have a chance to play. At the travel level, playing time is not guaranteed. The game schedule has not been finalized at this time but will run from January through early March. This program features one or two practices per week, starting in late December, and one to three games per week. Once registered, refunds will not be given. If your child decides to not play before the start of the season, we will credit your RecDesk account for you to use for future events/programs. Registration for Travel Volleyball will open on October 26th and close on November 15th. The fee is \$85.00 per player. There will be a discounted fee for individuals with rec center memberships.



Father-Daughter Dance

Fathers, here is your chance to take your favorite girl(s) out for a night of fun and dancing! This promises to be a night to remember, full of fun, music, games, and plenty of dancing! Enjoy sandwiches, treats, refreshments, a photo booth, balloon artist, and a DJ! All of the girls will bring home a special gift! The Father-Daughter Dance will take place at the El Paso Rec Center on Saturday, February 6th from 6:00 PM – 8:00 PM. Registration will open on December 21st and close on February 3rd. You must register as a couple. The fee for a couple is \$25.00 and there is a \$10.00 fee for any additional daughters. This special event is for daughters that are 12 years old and under and all of the daughters must be accompanied by a caregiver.



Mother-Son Nerf Night

Enjoy a night out with your child and participate in the third Mother/Son Nerf night. There will be deli sandwiches, cookies, and drinks throughout the night. During your time, games will be played, and target stations will be set up!

Nerf Night 2027 will take place on Saturday, March 6th from 6:00 P.M. to 8:00 P.M. at the American Buildings Rec Center. Registration for the Mother-Son Nerf Night will open on January 4th and close on March 3rd. The participant fee is \$25.00 per child, or \$10.00 per sibling. We will be able to provide some Nerf guns, but it is encouraged to bring your own as well. We will provide all Nerf bullets, so please do not bring yours. You will be required to wear eye protections, so if you have glasses or goggles that you prefer, please bring those as well.

Travel Soccer

Travel Soccer is being offered for soccer players that are looking for a higher level of play and an advanced playing situation. This program is designed to give the soccer player the opportunity to play against other quality teams from the surrounding area and competes with other travel teams in the area which is structured to be more competitive. This program is offered through El Paso Parks & Recreation in House Soccer program.

Spring Travel Soccer will be having teams for U10, and U12. This program features assigned teams, one or two practices per week, starting in late March, and one or two games per week, going from early April to mid-May. Registration for Travel Soccer will open on January 18th and close on February 28th.

The age groups are based on your child's birth year:

U10- 2017 birthday and younger

U12- 2015 birthday and younger

The fee is \$110.00 per player for the season. Every player will receive a jersey that must be turned in at the end of the season. There will be a \$25 charge to your account for all jerseys that are not returned at the end of the season.

In-House Soccer

In-house Soccer is for children that are currently in Pre-Kindergarten through Fourth Grade. All of the athletes must be at least four years of age as of Saturday, April 5th, 2027 to participate. This program features assigned teams, one or two practices per week, and one or two games per week. Registration for In-House Soccer begins on February 1st and closes on March 14th. The roster, game schedule, practice schedule, and rules will be issued after the registration deadline. This league will take place in El Paso and participate with teams from Hudson, Lexington and Minonk if they are able to field teams. Practices will begin in late March, and the games will begin on April 10th and end on May 8th if we have to use the rain date. The season will consist of 4 weeks of games but will consist of 6 total games. Two of the weeks your team will have a doubleheader.

There will be a scheduled rain out date to make up any games that are postponed. That date will be May 8th, 2027.

The fee is \$40.00 per player and each player will receive a T-shirt.

Refunds will not be issued. A credit to your account will only be issued if registration has not closed.

Summer

Baseball

El Paso Recreation offers our baseball program from the Pre-Kindergarten (must be four years old) age through the 7th Grade. All practices are conducted here in El Paso with game locations being determined by grade level. Each participant will receive a T-Shirt and a hat for the baseball season.

Age groups and leagues are as follows:

Tee-ball (Boys & Girls)- 4-6 years old
Instructional (Boys & Girls)- 6-8 years old
8U, 10U & 12U Softball

Tee-ball

Tee-ball will consist of approximately 10 boys and girls per team. Coaches will be on the field for guidance and assistance. Games will be played on Dairy Queen Field in El Paso from mid-May to late June. Games will be played on Friday evenings and Saturday mornings. Teams will play six games. Registration for Tee-ball opens on March 15th and closes on April 12th.

The fee is \$40.00 per player.

Instructional

Instructional Baseball for boys and girls will consist of just El Paso teams, if we can acquire enough participants. If we do not, we will try to join up in a league with Hudson and Minonk. All of the games will be at Dairy Queen Field in El Paso. In this league the coaches pitch to the boys and girls. Games will run from mid-May to late June. There will be a total of 6 games, and they will take place on Friday evenings and Saturday mornings depending on field availability. Registration for Instructional Baseball opens on March 15th and closes on April 12th.

The fee is \$40.00 per player.

8U Travel Baseball

8U Travel Baseball is for children that are eight years old (as of April 30, 2027) and younger. This program features a pitching machine, assigned teams, one or two practices per week, and one or two games per week. Registration for 8U Travel Baseball opens on January 11th and closes on March 8th. The roster, game schedule, practice schedule, and rules will be issued in late-April. The games begin on Mid-May and the end of season tournament will be in late June.

The fee is \$75.00 per player. The registration fee will cover their jersey and hat.

10U & 12U Travel Baseball

Travel Baseball is for children that are 12 years old (as of April 30, 2027) and younger. This program features assigned teams, one or two practices per week, and one or two games per week. Registration for Travel Baseball opens on January 11th and closes on March 8th. The roster, game schedule, practice schedule, and rules will be issued in late-April. The games begin Mid-May and the end of season tournament will be in late June.

The fee is \$100.00 per player. The registration fee will include their jersey and hat.

Softball

El Paso Recreation offers our softball program from the Pre-Kindergarten (must be four years old) age through 6th Grade (12U). All practices are conducted here in El Paso with game locations being determined by grade level. Each participant will receive T-Shirt and hat for the softball season.

Age groups and leagues are as follows:

Tee-ball (Boys & Girls)- 4-6 years old
Instructional (Boys & Girls)- 6-8 years old
8U, 10U & 12U Softball



Tee-ball

Tee-ball will consist of approximately 10 boys and girls per team. Coaches will be on the field for guidance and assistance. Games will be played on Dairy Queen Field in El Paso from mid-May to late June. Games will be played on Friday evenings and Saturday mornings. Teams will play six games. Registration for Tee-ball opens on March 15th and closes on April 12th.

The fee is \$40.00 per player.

Instructional

Instructional Baseball for boys and girls will consist of just El Paso teams, if we can acquire enough participants. If we do not, we will try to join up in a league with Hudson and Minonk. All of the games will be at Dairy Queen Field in El Paso. In this league the coaches pitch to the boys and girls. Games will run from mid-May to late June. There will be a total of 6 games, and they will take place on Friday evenings and Saturday mornings depending on field availability. Registration for Instructional Baseball opens on March 15th and closes on April 12th. We do not take requests to play on a specific team. Only siblings will be placed on the same teams automatically.

The fee is \$40.00 per player.

8U Travel Softball

8U Travel Softball is for children that are eight years old (as of April 30, 2027) and younger. This program features a pitching machine, assigned teams, one or two practices per week, and one or two games per week. Registration for 8U Travel Softball opens on January 11th and closes on March 8th. The roster, game schedule, practice schedule, and rules will be issued in late-April. The games begin on Mid-May and the end of season tournament will be in late June.

The fee is \$75.00 per player. The registration fee will cover their jersey and hat/headband.

10U & 12U Travel Softball

Travel Softball is for children that are 12 years old (as of April 30, 2027) and younger. This program features assigned teams, one or two practices per week, and one or two games per week. Registration for Travel Softball opens on January 11th and closes on March 8th. The roster, game schedule, practice schedule, and rules will be issued in late-April. The games begin Mid-May and the end of season tournament will be in late June.

The fee is \$100.00 per player. The registration fee will include their jersey and hat/headband.





Fall

In-House Soccer

In-House Soccer is for children that are going from Pre-Kindergarten through Fourth Grade. All of the athletes must be at least four years of age as of Saturday, August 16, 2026, to participate. This program features assigned teams, one practice per week, and one or two games a week that will take place on Saturday mornings and afternoons. Registration for fall In-House Soccer begins on June 25th and closes on July 23rd. The roster, game schedule, practice schedule, and rules will be issued after the registration deadline. This league will take place in El Paso and participate with teams from Hudson, Lexington and Minonk if they are able to field teams.

The games will begin August 15th and end September 19th. If a weekend is canceled due to weather, the rain date will be September 26th. The season will consist of 5 weeks of games but consist of 6 games. There will be no games scheduled over Corn Festival weekend, which is September 5th.

The fee is \$40.00 per player and each player will receive a T-shirt. Once the program begins, no refunds will be given.

Travel Soccer

Travel Soccer is being offered for soccer players that are looking for a higher level of competition and an advanced playing situation. This program is designed to give the soccer players from El Paso-Gridley the opportunity to play against other quality teams from the surrounding area. This program competes with other travel teams in the area which is structured to be more competitive than the El Paso Parks & Recreation in House Soccer program.

Fall Travel Soccer will be having teams for 10U, 12U. This program features assigned teams, one or two practices per week with most games taking place from late August to early October on Saturdays and Sundays. There will be additional games scheduled throughout the week, but those games have not been set at this time. Registration for fall Travel Soccer begins on June 25th and closes on July 23rd.

The age groups are based on your child's birth year:

U10- 2016 birthday and younger

U12- 2014 birthday and younger

The fee is \$120.00 per player for the season. Every player will receive a jersey that must be turned in at the end of the season. There will be a \$25 charge to your account for all jerseys that are not returned at the end of the season

Titan Junior Gymnastics

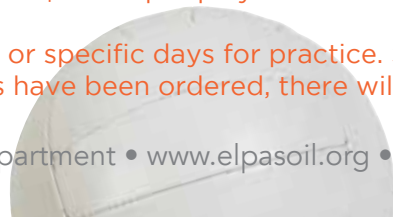

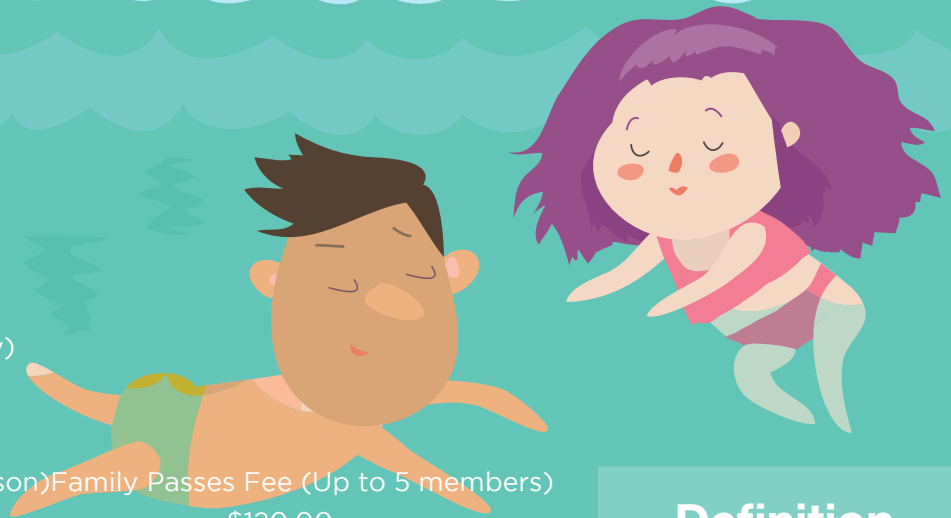

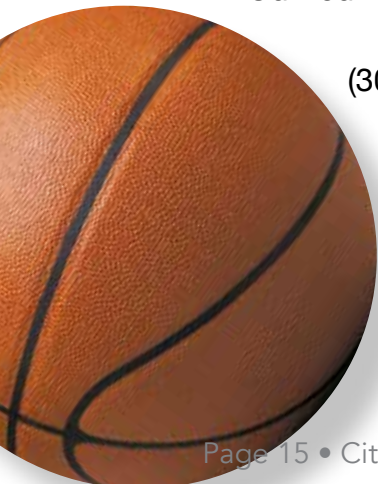
